On Ascension Day, May 31st 2019, Mirembe celebrated its 40st Anniversary.

A picture taken on that day, on the Hello World manifestation at Boxmeer, shows Irene enthusiastically addressing passing visitors. She is radiating pleasure, promoting her foundation for the last time!. On that very day she stepped down from the board of Mirembe. Her health condition did allow her to continue.

Sunday, May 29th, three years later, brought the final goodbye. We all of Mirembe foundation, feel somehow like orphans.
