

ENF and UCMTI Access to Clean and Safe water Report

Elizabeth Namaganda Foundation and The Uganda Catholic Management Institute get permanent access to clean water through Stichting Mirembe. The two organizations were supported following water shortage challenges at the restaurant and the Institute. They both joined forces for a quick and permanent solution: borehole drilling. The proposal was supported by Stichting Mirembe with a contribution of UGX 18,989,000 and was successfully implemented. After drilling, water was channeled to different distribution points, the school main water tanks and the ENF restaurant. Please find the pictorial report below:
